National Anti-Bullying Week 19<sup>th</sup>-23<sup>rd</sup> November 2007

Surrey County Council is holding an event to promote anti-bullying and we would like you to be involved.

The event is to support schools with solution-focused approaches, to launch Surrey's revised anti-bullying strategy; start work on a Charter Mark for Surrey schools using pupils to evaluate school's performance; and to promote partnership working between school staff and young people.

There will be speakers, a DVD, lunch and workshops for school leadership teams and pupils to work together to stop bullying. A programme has been sent to schools with this letter, and a booking form asking for the names of two members of staff, and two student school council representatives.

Surrey Youth Parliament would like you to talk to your Headteacher to see if you can take part as a school, and if you can, nominate two members to accompany your Headteacher and one other, or up to two senior members of the schools leadership team, to attend the event.

This will be a fantastic opportunity to see how other schools, and the whole of Surrey are trying to put a stop to bullying.

You will be able to take the information back into school to come up with an effective anti-bullying strategy. We hope you will be able to join us.
