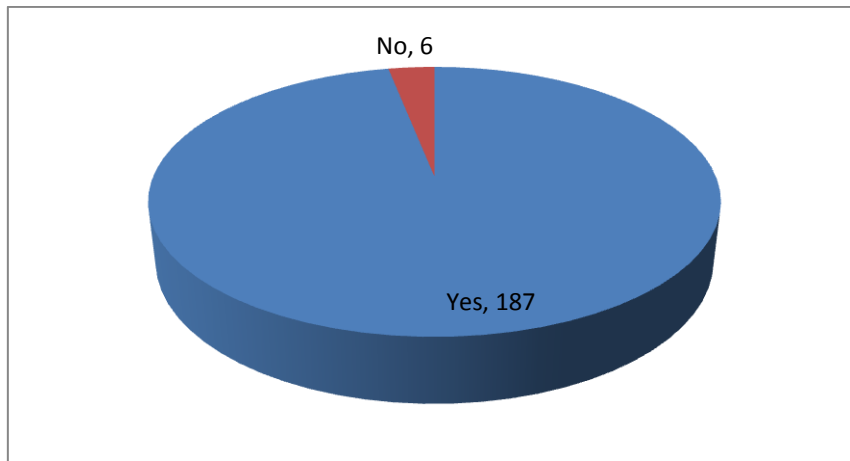

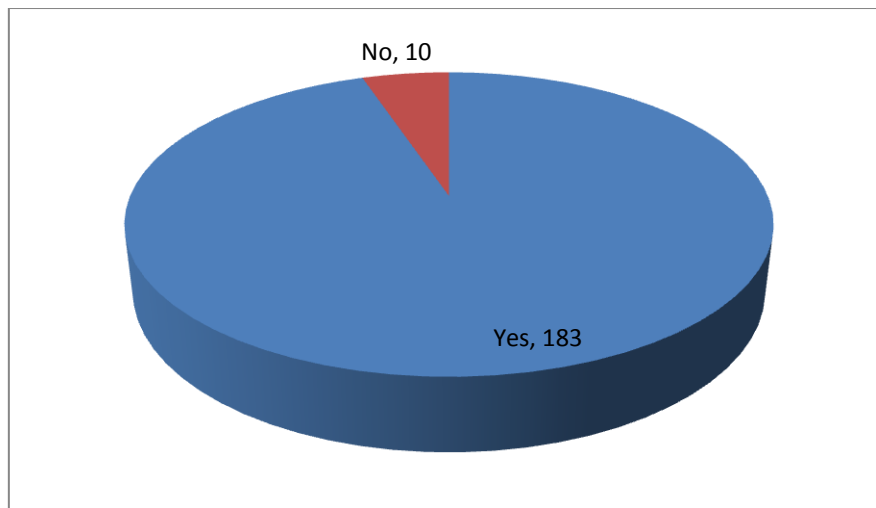

Having watched SHOW ONE! By Pink Triangle Theatre:

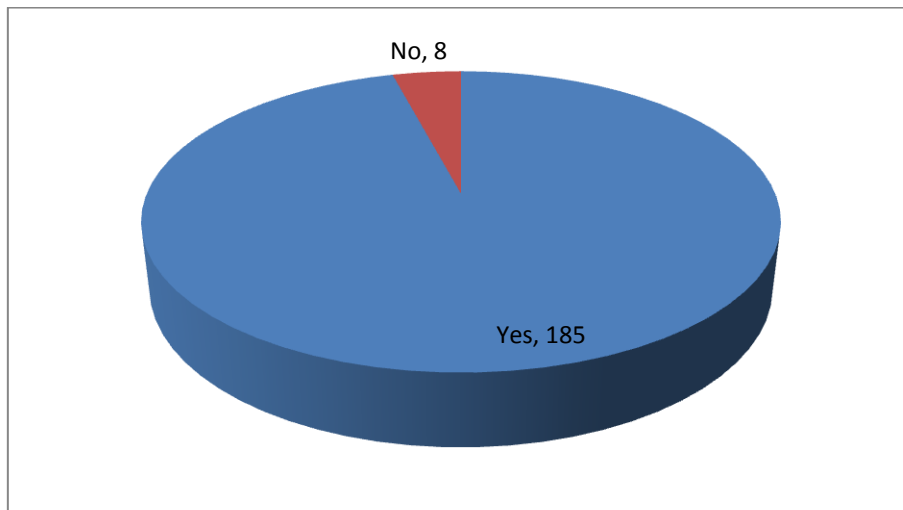
Do you have a better understanding of what homophobia means?
